Fort Campbell lies on the Kentucky-Tennessee border between the cities of Hopkinsville, KY and Clarksville, TN, and is about 60 miles northwest of Nashville on I-24. Fort Campbell supports the 3rd largest military population in the Army and the 7th largest in the Department of Defense. At 164 square miles (105,068 Acres), the installation is one of the largest in the world. Today, approximately 12,000 acres of the installation have been developed into the cantonment area while the remaining 93,000+ acres of the reservation are dedicated to training and firing ranges. Although nearly two-thirds of the 105,000 acres of post are actually in Tennessee, the post office is located in Kentucky, and the identification lies with that state.
