

Alabama Interstate Access Expected To Spur Growth and Enhance Safety

The new Interstate 65 interchange in Limestone County Alabama will offer more than an expected economic boom. It will enhance safety.

The interchange is at Huntsville-Browns Ferry Road in Tanner where the Athens and Huntsville city limits meet on its eastern side because of Huntsville's annexations.

Alabama Department of Transportation Division Engineer Johnny Harris said construction is in its final stages, and the interchange could be ready within two weeks.

Officials have said the interchange will enhance access to the Tennessee Valley Authority Megasite in southern Limestone County, and open up the area for growth.
